Seaboard Station operated as a passenger station from 1885 until 1968, continuing as a freight station through the 1980s. After years of vacancy and disrepair, the structure was restored to its original stately grandeur by the Suffolk-Nansemond Historical Society. Now the museum stands as one of Suffolk's most beloved landmarks and is operated by Suffolk Tourism. The Museum is open daily 10 am - 5 pm. Closed Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.
